**Who should  
attend?**

This course is designed for people who want to receive our most thorough first aid training. It is most suited to those working in high-risk environments, such as building sites or warehouses.

This course is for people wishing to update their first aid skills, and to renew an existing, valid First Aid at Work certificate.

This course is suitable for anyone aged 16+ who is designated as a workplace first aider in a low-risk environment such as an office, retail space, or similar. Previous first aid experience not required.

Suitable for people working with young children and those working towards an early years educator qualification.

**Course content  
and outcomes**

This course provides a comprehensive set of practical skills needed by first aiders in most workplaces, giving both the ability and knowledge to deal with first aid emergencies. Successful learners will receive a St John Ambulance certificate, valid for three years.

This course updates the first aid skills of those who need to renew their First Aid at Work certificate. Successful learners will receive a St John Ambulance certificate, valid for three years.

Training is delivered in two parts—online and face-to-face—and covers key topics including CPR, choking, bleeding, seizures, shock, burns, and the role of the first aider. It also includes defibrillator prompts and how to respond. Successful learners will receive a St John Ambulance certificate, valid for three years. This meets the HSE requirements.

Working in partnership with the Early Years Alliance, this course focuses on emergency scenarios that can happen when looking after young children and infants.
