- Learning from incidents.

Assessment

This course is assessed with a workplace health and safety review for Unit HSA1. This will include:

- Considering how health and safety is managed, and how it could be done better
- > Identifying health and safety issues, how they are controlled and if the risk can be reduced
- > Selecting the most important issue for improvement.

This assessment must be carried out at your own workplace, or at a suitable premises if this is not possible.
